PAYMENT METHODS:

- Monthly: 12 payments, on the 1st of each month, beginning on June 1
- Quarterly: 4 payments, on June 1, September 1, December 1, and March 1
There will be no service fee charged with this method if payments are made on time.
- Semesterly: 2 payments on June 1 and December 1
There will be no service fee charged with this method if payments are made on time.
- Annually: 1 payment on June 1
A three percent (3%) discount off of the tuition amount is available to families that elect to pay the entire year's fees and the full tuition amount in advance. In order to be eligible for this discount, payment of all fees and tuition must be received by May 31, 2008
- A discount of five percent (5%) is available to any family who pays the Annual amount by April 1st

NOTES:

- Late Fee of \$25.00 for all payments received after the 5th of the month.
- Audits to accounts are subject to a \$50.00 service charge.
- All NSF checks will be charged a \$50.00 service fee per item.
- The Graduation Fee is due on May 1, 2009.
- To be eligible for any of the above discounts, enrollment fee and book fee must be paid in full prior to June 1, 2008. A limited amount of financial aid is available for qualified applicants. To be eligible for consideration, applications for financial aid must be received no later than April 30, 2008.
- Any account that is 45 days or more past due will be in jeopardy of losing any and all discounts, financial aid, and other assistance that may have been granted. If accounts reach 60 days past due, students may be subject to removal from the school. Report Cards and school records will not be released until all account balances are paid in full. Students with delinquent accounts (past 45 days) may not be permitted to attend Extended Care or participate in any extracurricular activities and events.
- If you withdraw your student, you are financially responsible for the balance owed, irrespective of the payment plan chosen, regardless of the withdrawal date. A penalty for withdrawal will be assessed equal to one month's full tuition.
