### AFTER-SCHOOL ENRICHMENT PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

**Art:** Creative expression is an essential component in child development. Art classes are taught by our very own Daniella Rosset. Our young artists will work in various mediums to produce complex multi-week projects. Completed pieces will be taken home at their completion. All of the materials for the class will be provided.

**Ballet:** Dance is another creative outlet for children. We are thrilled to offer ballet lessons to our students. Participants will learn balance and posture while building positive body images and physical fitness. Dancers should wear leotards, tights and ballet slippers to class.

**Mind Lab:** Mind Lab offers students a fun way to practice skills such as perception, memory, problem solving and decision making. Board games have proven effective ways to enhance development, intelligence and motivation. During each class the students will be introduced to a new fun and challenging game. The skills taught to master the game can be integrated into everyday problem solving at home and at school. Participants will enjoy the fast paced exciting games so much that they don't even realize that they are learning!

**Hip Hop Dance:** Come get movin' and groovin'!. The first 25 minutes will include a warm-up and movement combinations similar to the choreography in "High School Musical" that includes rhythm, musicality, and kinesthetic awareness. Attire is a T-shirt and sweat pants. Tennis shoes or bare feet are fine for Hip-Hop.

**Chess:** This course is specifically designed for kids who want to start out studying chess. Kids study the basic elements of chess: the chess board, the various chess pieces, how they move and how they capture opponent pieces. They learn the special moves like castling, pawn promotion and en passant. Special attention is paid to the fundamental concepts of check, checkmate and stalemate and their continuous practice. A lesson normally consists of a lecturing part and a practical part where the kids play chess and practice.

**Fired Up Youth Sports:** Join our on-site after-school sports program that features flag football, soccer, basketball, t-ball, baseball, floor/field hockey and speed and agility. Program will teach students the fundamental of sports, whether they are looking to reinforce a healthy lifestyle or develop the building blocks of future athletic success. All coaches were trained by an NSCA certified instructor.

**Etiquette:** The lesson topics vary, but are focused on etiquette, which they define as "helping others to feel valued." Our classes are hands-on and include an interactive story, accompanying song, role playing activity, and either a craft or a simple "cooking" project that goes along with each lesson. Each participant will receive a t-shirt, a "set right" placemat and a CD of etiquette songs.

**Smart & Bright Robotics:** Especially designed for girls and boys, 7 to 12 years old. We combine engineering skills with visual-spatial activities to be able to offer a week packed with knowledge, fun and entertainment, based on teamwork, computer programming, and robot assembly.
